In the prize-winning design for debitel, one of the largest mobile phone providers in Germany, the paved piazza between the debitel building and the gastronomic service center is the heart of the diverse office complex. With a richness that overlaps a multitude of senses and dimensions, the landscape provides a setting to be enjoyed by all.

For those looking to sit and relax, there is a choice between the outdoor seating around the small cafe and the shaded seating under the blocks of trees. Nearby, illuminated fountains sprouting from the ground with changing water heights and colors are a visual delight. Two water lily basins set in a carpet of grass are the generating base pattern of the parterre level. A pergola over a wooden terrace at the basin and a screened field of roses provide a subtly defined array of heights and spatial differentiation.

Planted fruit trees in the "park of memories" limit the garden level. They take on the typical and local elements of the surrounding landscape.
