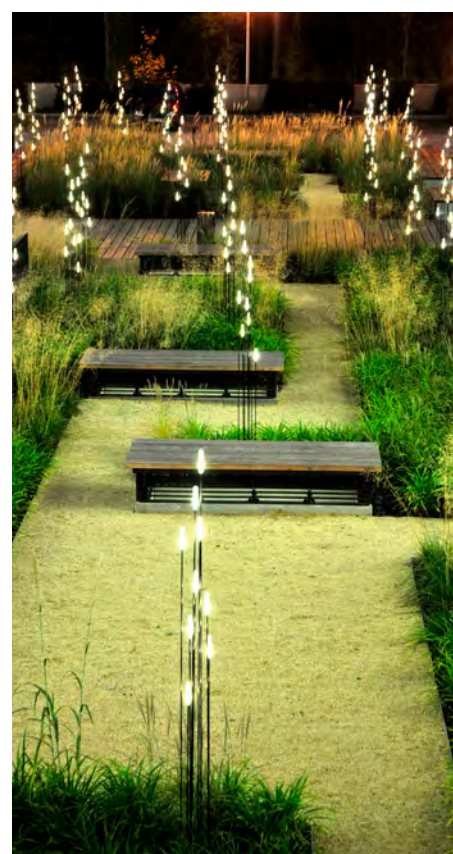

Stuttgart is the site of the new EnBW corporate group headquarters. The integration and design of the company grounds plays an important role in the quality and reception of the design proposal for the entire facility. The landscape design concept creates a flowing transition from urban structure and spaces into a valuable nature reserve area. This is achieved by terracing the urban piazza and courtyards towards the gardens beyond, implementing a transition zone of existing trees towards the forest and referring to the existing urban fabric of the city. The stone piazza at the foot of the multi-story building becomes the public center of the complex. The line of trees along the road is opened up at the piazza area, creating a clear welcoming gesture toward the city. The area invites one to linger and may be used for public events or as an outdoor area for the adjoining restaurants as well. The representative character of the three courtyards is supported by classic landscape design elements. The conceptually portrayed natural elements water, wind and sun are central themes.









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
