

The forecourt of the House of Youth, established since the 1950s, was renovated and redesigned as part of the urban development program „Growth and Sustainable Renewal“. A modern city square for young people and children has been created. The walls and railings were renewed in accordance with the listed building standards and surfaces were made with color-coordinated natural stone coverings. The meeting place is characterized by a high-quality, polygonal concrete slab paving with a red accent in the middle, which defines a stage for performances and events. The trees facing the building have been preserved. A new landscape island with an integrated seating element is being built on Leipziger Strasse, and implemented with almond trees.
