Following the renovation of the harbour wall and the reopening of Weser lock, the central square of Bad Karlshafen in North Hessen has been given a new look. The surrounding open spaces were remodelled within the historical context, creating new areas where people can stroll and linger, plus opportunities to establish gastronomy and hold events. A total of 41 roof form lime trees were planted in a hydraulically bound layer. The surface is paved in a fan pattern with regional Weser sandstone and, facing the water, with large-format natural stone slabs. The baroque planned city and its inner city harbour district now has new lighting effects that highlight important buildings and elements with subtle glowing illumination. In the evening, together with new street lighting, it presents a harmonious picture.
