Turngemeinde 1837 Hanau a. V. is planning to build a new three-court sports hall with outdoor and transport facilities on the existing Jula-Hof sports complex in Hanau. In addition to the new three-court sports hall, a car park, a bicycle parking facility, the entrance area and a terrace to the west are planned to the east of the hall.

The three-court sports hall with open-air and traffic facilities will be accessed from the east via Philipp-August-Schleißner-Weg. The entire site is secured with a fence system. This will be partially renewed, adapted or repaired in accordance with the planning. Pedestrians and cyclists can safely enter the grounds of the gymnastics club via a new double-leaf gate and a separate footpath and cycle path. The approximately 3.80 metre wide path, which leads directly to the entrance of the hall, allows both user groups to arrive safely. The contrasting colour of the footpath and cycle path clearly separates it from car traffic and also creates greater safety and clarity of use. In addition, the reddish (brick-red) epoxy resin coating with white line markings is reminiscent of classic sports running tracks, making it particularly eye-catching.


To the south, the main path is accompanied by planting strips with richly structured and low-maintenance planting, which provide a contrast to the paved areas. The planting strips also provide privacy and a spatial boundary to the neighbouring bicycle parking facility. 16 new deciduous trees will be planted.

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

Turngemeinde 1837 Hanau a. V. is planning to build a new three-court sports hall with open-air and transport facilities on the existing Jula-Hof sports complex in Hanau, as well as remodelling and redesigning the existing sports facility. The Hanau - Friedberg railway line runs to the west of the site. Residential buildings border the sports facility to the north and east, a football pitch to the south and the Kinziga floodplain behind it. Some of the existing sports facilities are to be renovated, redesigned and rebuilt. Three new beach volleyball courts will be built in the south. Three tennis courts will be resurfaced. The archery range will be relocated to the north. A new synthetic surface will be laid on parts of the existing running track.

around the entire site of the sports centre. The entire TGH site will be remodelled for the new plans. Existing structures such as the fire brigade access road to the tennis centre, the barbecue hut and tennis centre will remain.
